### Phoenixville Police Awarded Accreditation Status Until 2023

The Phoenixville Police values statement plaque, hanging on the wall in the lobby entrance, lists professionalism as one of them. Accreditation equates the pinnacle of professionalism. This process would not come to fruition without the fortitude and devotion of Chief Thomas Sjostrom, Lieutenant Brian Marshall and Sergeant Joseph Nemic read a release from the Phoenixville Police Department. According to inter-office communication written by Sjostrom, the acknowledgment of the accreditation was the result of the recommendation of assessors who visited their department this past December. 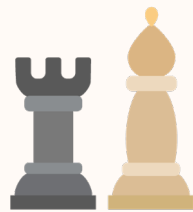
