

ORDINANCE NO 2012 - 2191

BOROUGH OF PHOENIXVILLE  
CHESTER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 15 "MOTOR VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC" PART 2, "TRAFFIC REGULATIONS", SECTION 15-224 BY AMENDING "LOADING AND UNLOADING ZONES", PART 4 "GENERAL PARKING REGULATIONS", SECTION 15-402 BY AMENDING "PARKING PROHIBITED AT ALL TIMES IN CERTAIN LOCATIONS", AND SECTION 15-406 BY CHANGING THE NUMBER OF "HANDICAPPED PARKING ZONES" IN THE BOROUGH OF PHOENIXVILLE, CHESTER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA

The Council of the Borough of Phoenixville, Chester County, Pennsylvania hereby ORDAINS that:

**SECTION 1.**

Chapter 15, "Motor Vehicles and Traffic," Part 2, "Traffic Regulations," Section 15-224, "Loading and Unloading Zones," is hereby amended as indicated by the black line and strikeout interlineations below, with strikeout indicating deletions of language and underlined interlineations indicating insertions of language:

Highway	Side	Between
Church Street	South	From a point 346 feet west of the southwest corner of <u>Main Gay Street</u> . A <b>15 Minute Parking – Loading Zone</b> sign should be placed at a point on the south side of Church Street facing west.

**SECTION 2.**

Chapter 15, "Motor Vehicles and Traffic," Part 4, "General Parking Regulations," Section 15-402, "Parking Prohibited at All Times in Certain Locations," is hereby amended as indicated by the black line and strikeout interlineations below, with strikeout indicating deletions of language and underlined interlineations indicating insertions of language:

Street	Side	Between
Starr Street	West	At a point 30 feet south of the southwest corner of Church Street on the west side of Starr Street. A <i>No Parking</i> sign shall be placed with the sign facing <u>north</u> south.
Starr Street	East	At a point 460 feet south of the southeast corner of Bridge Street on the east side of Starr Street. A <i>No Parking Corner to Here</i> sign shall be placed with the sign facing <u>south</u> north.

**SECTION 3.**

Chapter 15, "Motor Vehicles and Traffic," Part 4, "Traffic Regulations," Section 15-406, "Handicapped Parking Zones," is hereby amended as indicated by the black line and strikeout interlineations below, with strikeout indicating deletions of language and underlined interlineations indicating insertions of language:

Street	Side	Location
<u>Cherry Street</u>	<u>West</u>	<u>Beginning at a point 163 feet south of the southwest corner of Chester Avenue on the west side of Cherry Street; thence from said point of beginning to a point 20 feet in northerly direction from the point and place of beginning. The sign should face</u>

north and a **Reserved Penalties** sign should be mounted below it.

Church Street	South	<del>195 feet from the intersection of the south side of Church Street and the west side of Main Street, thence from a point of beginning to a point on the south side of Church Street, 22 feet in an easterly direction from the point and place of beginning.</del>
Grover Street	North	<del>Beginning at a point 89 feet east of the northeast corner of Lincoln Avenue on the north side of Grover Street; thence from said point of beginning to a point 20 feet in an easterly direction from the point and place of beginning. The sign should face east and a <b>Reserved Penalties</b> sign should be mounted below it.</del>
Hall Street		<del>8 Hall Street</del>
W. High Street	South	<del>570 W. High Street</del>
Milligan Street	North	<del>Opposite 316 Milligan Street.</del>
Washington Avenue	South	<del>Beginning at a point 131 feet east of the southeast corners of Buchanan Street on the south side of Washington Avenue; thence from said point of beginning to a point 20 feet in an easterly direction from the point and place of beginning. The sign should face east and a <b>Reserved Penalties</b> sign should be mounted below it.</del>

**SECTION 4.**

If any sentence, clause, section, or part of this Ordinance is for any reason found to be unconstitutional, illegal or invalid, such unconstitutionality, illegality or invalidity shall not affect or impair any of the remaining provisions, sentences, clauses, parts, or section hereof. It is hereby declared as the intent of the Borough Council that this Ordinance would have been adopted had such unconstitutional, illegal, or invalid sentence, clause, part or section thereof not been included herein.

**SECTION 5.**

All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances conflicting or inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

**SECTION 6.**

This Ordinance shall become effective upon enactment as provided by law.
