Driveway and Sidewalk Construction Standards

§25-203 (1) Prohibited Acts


No person, firm or corporation shall remove, destroy, break, cut, prune, trim, scrape, paint, whitewash or in any way deface, injure or interfere with the roots, trunk, bark, branches, leaves, flowers or fruit of any public shade trees in the Borough of Phoenixville without the permission of the Borough Manager for the work to be done. **Compliance with this part shall be confirmed by contacting the Codes Office for a field inspection previous to installation of the finish product.**

§21-1101 Driveway Construction

Driveways shall be constructed either of concrete or bituminous concrete, including that portion between the sidewalk and the street, the same to be installed consistent with good construction practices as defined by the Borough Manager in a writing made part of the Borough Records.

§21-307 Material and Specifications for Sidewalks


- 1) All sidewalks hereafter constructed, reconstructed or repaired in the Borough shall be made of concrete, according to specifications adopted by the Borough from time to time, such specifications to meet a maximum 3,000 pound compression test in 28 days.
- 2) All sidewalks shall be broom finished.
- 3) When there is danger of freezing, 2% of calcium chloride shall be added to the batch and the finished work shall be covered with salt hay.
- 4) All concrete shall be placed in a single course and finished without the addition of top mortar.
- 5) Sidewalks shall be laid to the line and grade obtained in advance from the Borough Manager, with a slope of 1/4 inch to the foot to the top of the curb.
- 6) Sidewalks shall be constructed with every block scored at six-foot intervals, with expansion strips every 30 feet.
- 7) The subgrade shall be firm and thoroughly tamped or rolled, and if so required by the Borough Manager, cinders or similar material shall be used before any concrete is placed.
- 8) In case of any sidewalk heretofore lawfully constructed of material other than concrete, such sidewalk may be repaired of the same material of which it was originally constructed, but if such sidewalk shall, at any time, be in such state if disrepair that, in the judgment of the Borough Manager, reconstruction, rather than repair, is necessary, such sidewalk shall be reconstructed of concrete and shall conform in all respect to the requirements of this Part applicable to new sidewalks.
- 9) Excepted from the above shall be sidewalks that are part of public works projects, which sidewalks may be constructed of materials other than concrete.


<u>DETAIL "A"</u> CONTRACTION JOINT

NOTES

- 1. PROVIDE MATERIALS AND CONSTRUCTION MEETING THE REQUIREMENTS OF PUBLICATION 408/2000, SECTION 630 FOR PLAIN CEMENT CONCRETE CURB AND DEPRESSED CURB, SECTION 640 FOR PLAIN CEMENT CONCRETE GUTTER AND SECTION 641 FOR PLAIN CEMENT CONCRETE CURB GUTTER.
- SPACE CONTRACTION JOINTS IN UNIFORM LENGTHS OR SECTIONS.
- 3. PLACE 3/4" PREMOLDED EXPANSION JOINT FILLER MATERIAL AT STRUCTURES AND AT THE END OF THE WORK DAY. CUT MATERIAL TO CONFORM TO AREA ADJACENT TO CURB OR TO CONFORM TO CROSS SECTIONAL AREA OF CURB.
- 4. SEE RC-50M FOR PLAIN CEMENT CONCRETE CURB SLOPED TOP TREATMENT AT END OF STRUCTURES.
- 5. ALL CONCRETE IS TO BE 3,500 P.S.I., CLASS AA.
- DEPRESSED CURB SHALL BE SLOPED 1/4" PER FOOT TOWARDS THE STREET.
- 7. CURB REPLACEMENT SHALL EXTEND TO THE NEAREST JOINT. SHOULD THE NEAREST JOINT EXTEND ACROSS A PROPERTY THE CURB MAY BE SAWCUT AT A LOCATION TO BE AND MARKED OUT BY THE BOROUGH.
- 8. CONTRACTOR SHALL PROVIDE EROSION CONTROLS TO CONTAIN OPEN EXCAVATIONS AND PROTECT THE NEAREST DOWNSTREAM INLET.


NOTES


CEMENT CONCRETE SIDEWALK

NOTES:

- 1. ALL CONCRETE IS TO BE 3,500 P.S.I., CLASS AA.
- DEPRESSED CURB SHALL BE SLOPED
 1/4" PER FOOT TOWARDS THE STREET.
- CONCRETE SHALL BE ALLOWED TO CURE FOR SEVEN (7) DAYS.
- 4. USE OF "HIGH EARLY" CONCRETE MAY BE APPROVED BY THE BOROUGH INSPECTOR.
- MONOLITHIC POURS SHALL ONLY BE PERMITTED BY SPECIAL EXCEPTION, AND ARE SUBJECT TO APPROVAL BY THE BOROUGH.
- CONTRACTOR SHALL PROVIDE EROSION CONTROLS TO CONTAIN OPEN EXCAVATIONS AND PROTECT THE NEAREST DOWNSTREAM INLET.

DRIVEWAY APRON CLASSES - MINIMUM STANDARDS:

- 1. RESIDENTIAL 6" THICKNESS WITH 6X6-W1.4/W1.4 WIREMESH REINFORCEMENT
- 2. COMMERCIAL 8" THICKNESS WITH 6X6-W2.1/W2.1 WIREMESH REINFORCEMENT
- 3. INDUSTRIAL DESIGN TO BE PROVIDED TO BOROUGH ENGINEER.
